In October 2018, the [Montclair State University's](#) School of Communication and Media (SCM) earned Silver LEED® (Leadership in Environmental and Energy Design) certification. This project is the third of four buildings Montclair State designed that meet the LEED standard and have been certified by the U.S. Green Building Council.

Montclair State chose [buildingplaques.com](#) to communicate the unique design elements of each building that earned LEED certification. The SCM building is an approximately 87,500-square-foot facility that joins Morehead Hall and Life Hall into a single, multi-functional communications and multimedia facility. The building is equipped with state-of-the-art 4K and high definition television control rooms and studios, a film studio, a multifaceted audio production center, the multi-platform News Lab, plus mediated classrooms, labs, and specialty rooms. Designed to foster industry partnerships, the School also houses the Center for Cooperative Media and is poised to become a leading national research center.
